




Young Carer Service

Home From Hospital

For anyone aged 18+

For anyone returning home after a stay in hospital. This short-term service can help with things such as collecting prescriptions, essential food shopping and helping to access appropriate support. 'At the point of referral, my partner had recently been discharged from hospital following a life threatening diagnosis and I was recovering from extensive major abdominal surgery and therefore unable to drive. Our family live out of area so we have minimal local support.

The support provided by HfH was outstanding during what was a very difficult time. Marie called, emailed and sent text messages to ensure the safety, health and well-being of myself and partner. She was professional, empathic, flexible and caring. She went to great lengths to ensure that our individual needs were met quickly and efficiently.

We are both extremely grateful for the support provided. It made such a difference emotionally and psychologically knowing that we were no longer having to deal with the practical but necessary daily living tasks on our own. '
