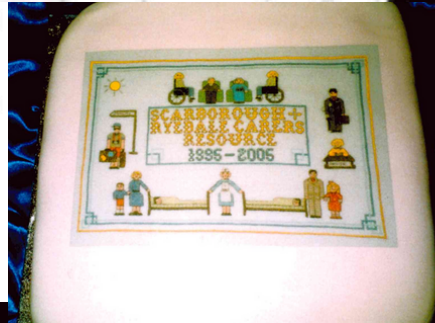

A service providing support and social activities with an emphasis on moving forward in life. The service helps to develop skills and confidence; encouraging the achievement of personal and professional goals.

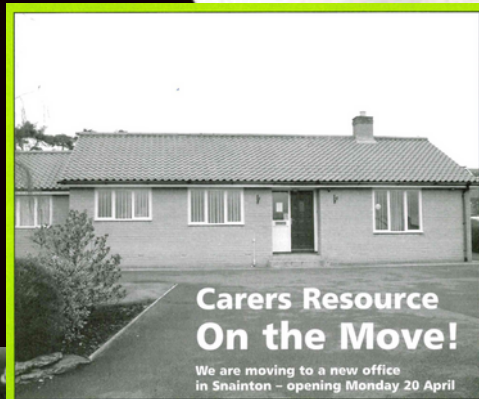

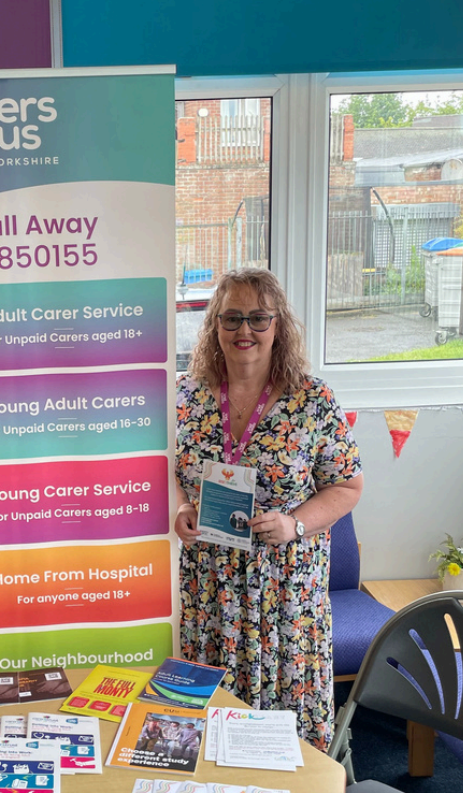

Helping young carers to confidently balance their caring responsibilities with everyday life opportunities. The service includes targeted activities, family support and opportunities to meet other young carers.



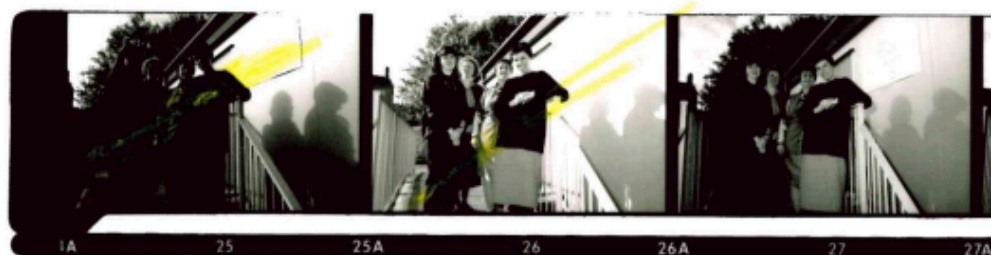

Home From Hospital

For anyone aged 18+

For anyone returning home after a stay in hospital. This short-term service can help with things such as collecting prescriptions, essential food shopping and helping to access appropriate support.

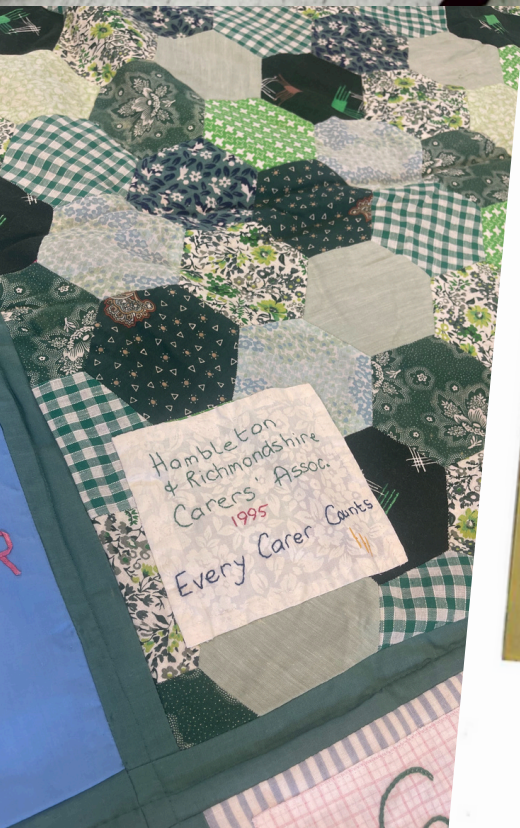


'At the point of referral, my partner had recently been discharged from hospital following a life threatening diagnosis and I was recovering from extensive major abdominal surgery and therefore unable to drive. Our family live out of area so we have minimal local support.
